



Dr. Hermano Igo Krebs has been a Principal Research Scientist at MIT's Mechanical Engineering Department and the Director of The77Lab. He holds an affiliate position as an Adjunct Professor at University of Maryland School of Medicine, and as a Visiting Professor at Fujita Health University, at Osaka University, and at Loughborough University. He is a Fellow of the IEEE. He received the 2009 Goldenson Technology and Rehabilitation Award from CPIRF and the 2015 IEEE-RAS INABA Technical Award. He was selected as a 2021 IEEE-EMBS Distinguished Lecturer. He was one of the founders and the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Interactive Motion Technologies from 1998 to 2016. He sold it to Bionik Laboratories, where he served as its Chief Science Officer and in the Board of Directors until July 2017. He later founded 4Motion Robotics.
